JOURNAVX MEDICATION INSTRUCTIONS v1.0

You have been prescribed a non-narcotic pain medication called Journavx (suzetrigine) which is for post-operative pain and short-term use in the first and second weeks after surgery. It is to be used in addition to your Tylenol and Advil and narcotic pain control regimen.

The following instructions are to help make your recovery as rapid and successful as possible incorporating the Journavx medication into your pain control regimen.

If your health insurance does not cover Journavx, you can visit the manufacturer's web site <https://www.journavx.com> and click on "Download the Journavx Savings Card." Bring this printout with you to the pharmacy to potentially help reduce the cost.

How to take your Journavx medication:

1. Journavx is a 50mg tablet taken twice a day (every 12 hours or so)
2. For your **FIRST Dose**, you should take 2 tablets (100mg) on an empty stomach
3. 12 hours after your first dose, you should then take 1 Journavx tablet every 12 hours for the first week after surgery
